The Advisory Fellow will be supporting the Advisory team with the following tasks:

 - Conducting background research and analysis, including in-depth literature reviews.
 - Assisting with data collection by preparing interview guides, attending interviews to summarize key takeaways, and administering online surveys.
 - Contributing to client presentations, including project milestones and final project reports.
- **Contributing to business development efforts** by crafting compelling project proposals and identifying potential partners to broaden our network in Colombia and beyond.
- **Providing ad hoc support** to other iGravity business lines as needed.
